Once the applicant's file is complete, including all references and statements, he/she will be notified regarding an interview with an administrator. Following the interview, the Admissions Council will then consider the application as quickly as possible. Admission to the Seminary may be granted on the basis of the application packet and interview, or may require additional information.
